I. THE ACT OF TRUSTING GOD

THE ACT: It's a choice

¹ To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul. ² O my God, in you I trust;
Psalm 25:1-2a (ESV)

II. THE ISSUE OF TRUSTING GOD

² O my God, in you I trust; let me not be put to shame; let not my enemies exult over me." Psalm 25:2 (ESV)

⁸ It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in man."
Psalm 118:8 (ESV)

⁵ Thus says the Lord: 'Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength,'" Jeremiah 17:5a (ESV)

THE ISSUE: I have to believe that God is going to take care of me.

III. THE BENEFIT OF TRUSTING GOD

³ Indeed, none who wait for you shall be put to shame; they shall be ashamed who are wantonly treacherous." Psalm 25:3 (ESV)

THE BENEFIT: When it's all said and done, I will not be ashamed of the way I lived and who I lived for.
