Persevere:

Warning #4: Don't Persist in Faithless Rebellion (Part #2)

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴ And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. Hebrews 10:19-25 (ESV)

How do we obey this warning?

#1: By heeding, vv.19-25.

Why to heed:

"Since" we have <u>access</u> and an <u>advocate</u>, vv.19-21.

"For" we have been warned, v.26.

How to heed:

- 1. Heed this exhortation to "draw near" so that you might stand, v.22.
- 2. Heed this exhortation to "hold fast" so that you might stand, v.23.
