Persevere: Warning #4: Don't Persist in Faithless Rebellion (Part #10)

³² And what more shall I say? For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets—³³ who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, ³⁴ quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. ³⁵ Women received back their dead by resurrection. Some were tortured, refusing to accept release, so that they might rise again to a better life. ³⁶ Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. ³⁷ They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were killed with the sword. They went about in skins of sheep and agats. destitute, afflicted, mistreated—³⁸ of whom the world was not worthy wandering about in deserts and mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth. ³⁹ And all these, though commended through their faith, did not receive what was promised, ⁴⁰ since God had provided something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect. Hebrews 11:32-40 (ESV)

How do we obey this warning?

#1: By heeding, 10:19-25.

#2: By looking, 10:32-39.

#3: By <u>imitating</u>, 11:1-12:2.

What kind of faith should we imitate?

- 1. Imitate the kind of faith that produces the fruit of obedience.
- 2. Imitate the kind of faith that looks past your current circumstances to what is promised.
- 3. Imitate the kind of faith that believes God even when His promise seems impossible.
- 4. Imitate the kind of faith that alters your self-identity.
- 5. Imitate the kind of faith that desires a better city.

- 6. Imitate the kind of faith that learns that God is the author of salvation.
- 7. Imitate the kind of faith that leaves a Godly legacy.
- 8. Imitate the kind of faith that fears God more than men.
- 9. Imitate the kind of faith that values the reproach of Christ more than the reward of this world.
- 10. Imitate the kind of faith that overcomes great fear by looking to God.
- **11.** Imitate the kind of faith that trusts God regarding judgment and salvation.
- 12. Imitate the kind of faith that steps out where others drown.
- 13. Imitate the kind of faith that obeys God even when His instructions seem foolish.
- 14. Imitate the kind of faith that risks it all because it believes God.
- 15. Imitate the kind of faith that finds victory even in spite of great <u>weakness</u>, vv.32-35a.
- 16. Imitate the kind of faith that keeps on trusting God even in the midst of great <u>suffering</u>, vv.35b-38.
- 17. Imitate the kind of faith that trusts God even though they did not <u>receive</u> what was promised before they died, vv.39-40.
