Areas of concentration for a Christian offering life worship in a non-Christian world (Heb. 13:1-25):

- 1. Offer to God a life that loves others, vv.1-3.
- 2. Offer to God a life that honors marriage, v.4.
- 3. Offer to God a life that is content, vv.5-6.

"Coveting is the opposite of contentment!"

Why is coveting so wrong?

- A. Stop coveting because it distorts your self-image.
 - *It gives an undue exaltation of self
 - *It gives an undue heightening of our innocence
- B. Stop coveting because it divides our affections.

- C. Stop coveting because it diminishes our effectiveness.
- D. Stop coveting because it damages our relationship.
